April 10, A.D. 1903 -

Know all men by these present, In the County of Upshur and State of Texas, The Last will of me, Jessey Robertson, of the County of Upshur and the state of Texas. Sound mind at the time of making and publishing this my last will and testament I give and devise all my estate real and personal when of I may die signed or possessed to my Chillings the land 100 acres to be ????? devied [sic] between the said names as follows One Hud [sic] acres of land lying in the County of Upshur of the hedright of William Britton Survey. This as follows: Ancie Robertson, Marlen Robertson, Ema Jones, dader of Jessey Robertson, Lona Robertson, Fifi Robertson, Willie Robertson, Mary Robertson, Lee Robertson, Jessey Robertson, Sara Jane Robertson, Our mule to my wife Peggie Robertson. Our cow to Sara Jane Robertson, Cow at Marlen Robertson, white and redd Spotted about four years old and calf. To have and to hold the same to themselves their heirs and assigns forever upon the user and I humbly give to my Chilling ~~and estate~~ wife to sell any or all of my real Estate at private or public sale and invest the proceeds or to lease the same as they may deem ~~but~~ but for the interest of themselves.
